



The Benè Berith Giovani Rome - Stefano Gaj Tachè Lodge, which President is Mister Angelo M. Di Nepi, regained vitality over the 10 last months and is very active in the field of Tzedakà, training and interfaith dialogue:

To encourage the experience of studying and working in the State of Israel, the Lodge promoted a grant of € 500.00 for young deserving people between 18 and 30 years old with few economic opportunities. This scholarship was dedicated to Stefano Gaj Tachè.

During the last holidays of Purim and Pesach, the Lodge has been active in giving Torah classes and collecting funds for the construction of food parcels intended for Jewish families in economic difficulties.

At the end of June, the Lodge sent its representatives to the interreligious meeting, the EI Conference.

In July, it organized, together with other associations, a lecture at The Great Synagogue of Roma with the Chief Rabbi of Rome, Riccardo Di Segni and Rav Colombo in memory of the three young Israeli boys killed by terrorism : Eyal, Gilad and Naftali.

Recently the Lodge purchased some siddurim for the synagogue of Tel Aviv on Rehov Ben Yehuda, subject to a fire that destroyed everything, including many prayer books.
